An Act to amend the Ministers of State Act 1952-1966.

[Assented to 27 February 1967]

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:--

1.--(1.) This Act may be cited as the Ministers of State Act 1967.

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Ministers of State Act* 1952-1966* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Ministers of State Act* 1952-1967.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives Commencethe Royal Assent.

3. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word Number of "twenty-five" and inserting in its stead the word "twenty-six".

4. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words salaries of "One hundred and ninety-one thousand three hundred dollars" and inserting in their stead the words "One hundred and ninety-seven thousand three hundred dollars".
