An Act to amend the Currency Act 1965.

[Assented to 8 April 1969]

B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

Commencement. 1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Currency Act 1969.

(2.) The Currency Act 1965* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Currency Act 1965-1969.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. Section 14 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting sub-sections Treasurer may issue coins. (3.) and (4.) and inserting in their stead the following sub-section:-

"(3.) In the making of a coin, a remedy in respect of weight (that is to say, a variation from the standard weight applicable to the coin) is allowable as prescribed.".

4. The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended by omitting the Standard composition of coins. words--

" Fifty cents | Four-fifths fine silver, one-fifth other metal " . . •• and inserting in their stead the words-

.. | Copper and nickel ". " Fifty cents
