

Judicial Appointment (Fiji)

No. 137 of 1971

An Act relating to the Acceptance and Holding of the Office of Chief Justice of Fiji by a Judge of the Commonwealth Industrial Court.

[Assented to 16 December 1971]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Judicial Appointment (Fiji) Act 1971*.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Section 103A (2.) of Conciliation and Arbitration Act not to apply to a certain appointment.

3. If the Honourable John Angus Nimmo, a Judge of the Commonwealth Industrial Court, accepts appointment to the office of Chief Justice of Fiji, sub-section (2.) of section 103A of the *Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1904–1970* does not apply in relation to his appointment to that office.
