AMENDMENT OF THE BANKING (STATISTICS) REGULATIONS†

Regulation 4 of the Banking (Statistics) Regulations is amended by omitting from the table in that regulation—

“Bank of China | 30th June”; and

(b) the words—

“Papua and New Guinea Development Bank .. | 30th June”.
