REGULATIONS UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT  
1901-1974.\*

## AMENDMENTS OF THE POSTAL REGULATIONS†

Redirection  
of postal  
articles.

### 1. Regulation 99 of the Postal Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (3) the word and figure “sub-regulation (3A)” and substituting the words and figures “sub-regulations (3A) and (3c)”;
- (b) by inserting after sub-regulation (3B) the following sub-regulation:—

“(3C) Where an application for redirection is made by a pensioner or a war widow pensioner, the fee referred to in whichever of paragraph (3) (a) or (b) is applicable is not payable in relation to the first month in respect of which redirection is applied for.”; and
- (c) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:—

“(8) In sub-regulation (3C), ‘pensioner’ and ‘war widow pensioner’ have the same meanings, respectively, as in regulation 29 of the Telephone Regulations.”.

### 2. Regulation 99A of the Postal Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (5) the word and figure “sub-regulation (5A)” and substituting the words and figures “sub-regulations (5A) and (5c)”;
- (b) by inserting after sub-regulation (5B) the following sub-regulation:—

“(5c) Where an application for the holding of mail is made by a pensioner or a war widow pensioner, the fee referred to in whichever of paragraph (5) (a) or (b) is applicable is not payable in relation to the first month in respect of which the holding of mail is applied for.”; and

(c) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:—
