

GOVERNOR-GENERAL AMENDMENT ACT 1977

No. 118 of 1977

An Act to amend the *Governor-General Act 1974* with respect to the salary of the Governor-General.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

Short title	1. This Act may be cited as the <i>Governor-General Amendment Act 1977</i> . ¹
Commencement	2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent, but the amendment made by section 3 does not have effect during the continuance in office of the person holding office as Governor-General immediately before the commencement of this Act.
	3. Section 3 of the <i>Governor-General Act 1974</i> ² is repealed and the following section substituted:
Salary of Governor-General	“3. The annual sum payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the salary of the Governor-General shall be \$37,000.”
