## ACTS INTERPRETATION AMENDMENT ACT 1978

## No. 35 of 1978

An Act to amend the Acts Interpretation Act 1901.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Acts Interpretation Amendment Short title Act 1978.
- (2) The Acts Interpretation Act 1901<sup>2</sup> is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives Commencethe Royal Assent.<sup>1</sup>
- 3. Section 19BA of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in Paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) " or the reference to that Minister is no longer appropriate "after" provision "(last occurring).

4. Section 19BC of the Principal Act is amended by inserting "to" Orders under sections 19B, 19BA and
