

ACTS INTERPRETATION AMENDMENT ACT 1978

No. 35 of 1978

An Act to amend the *Acts Interpretation Act* 1901.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Acts Interpretation Amendment Act* 1978.¹ Short title

(2) The *Acts Interpretation Act* 1901² is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.¹ Commence-
ment

3. Section 19BA of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) “ or the reference to that Minister is no longer appropriate ” after “ provision ” (last occurring). Reference to

4. Section 19BC of the Principal Act is amended by inserting “ to ” before “ be ”. Orders under
