

# Lighthouses Amendment Act 1979

No. 99 of 1979

An Act to amend the *Lighthouses Act* 1911 in consequence of certain amendments of the *Navigation Act* 1912.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Lighthouses Amendment Act* 1979.<sup>1</sup> Short title,  
&c.

(2) The *Lighthouses Act* 1911<sup>2</sup> is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.<sup>1</sup> Commence-  
ment

3. Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of “the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea” and substituting the following definition: Interpret-  
ation

“ ‘the Safety Convention’ has the same meaning as in Part IV of the Navigation Act 1912;”.

4. Section 7 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) “the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea” and substituting “the Safety Convention”. Power to
