Acts Interpretation Amendment Act 1980

An Act to amend the Acts Interpretation Act 1901

[Assented to 1 March 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

Short title, &c.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Acts Interpretation Amendment Act 1980.
- (2) The Acts Interpretation Act 1901 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Commencement

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 1980.

Headings, schedules, marginal notes, footnotes and endnotes

- 3. Section 13 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting sub-section (3) and substituting the following sub-section:
- "(3) No marginal note, footnote or endnote to an Act, and no heading to a section of an Act, shall be taken to be part of the Act.".
