

Parliamentary Joint Sittings Amendment Act 1981

No. 39 of 1981

An Act relating to joint sittings of the Parliament

[Assented to 1 May 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Joint Sittings Amendment Act 1981.

Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Amendment of Evidence Act

3. Section 2 of the *Evidence Act* 1905¹ is amended by adding "or held pursuant to any Act" at the end of the definition of "joint sitting of the Parliament".

Amendment of the Parliamentary Proceedings Broadcasting Act

4. Section 3 of the *Parliamentary Proceedings Broadcasting Act* 1946² is amended by adding "or held pursuant to any Act" at the end of the definition of "joint sitting" in sub-section (1).

Amendment of the Parliamentary Papers Act

5. Section 1A of the *Parliamentary Papers Act* 1908³ is amended by adding "or held pursuant to any Act" at the end of the definition of "joint sitting".
