Weights and Measures (National Standards) Regulations² (Amendment)

Regulation 5 of the Weights and Measures (National Standards) Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:

The metre

"5. The metre is the length of the path travelled by light in a vacuum during a time interval of $1/299\,792\,458$ of a second."
