Compensation (Commonwealth Government Employees) Regulations² (Amendment)

Principal Regulations

- 1. In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Compensation (Commonwealth Government Employees) Regulations.
- 2. The Principal Regulations are amended by adding after regulation 28 the following regulation:

Laws prescribed for the purposes of the Act

"29. For the purposes of the definition of 'prescribed law' in sub-section 121A (1) of the Act, each law of a State or Territory specified in a Part of Schedule 5 is declared to be a prescribed law for the purposes of the Act.".
