**Migration Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)**

**Commencement**

1. These Regulations commence on 19 December 1989.

**Principal Regulations**

2. In these Regulations, "Principal Regulations" means the Migration Regulations.

**Interpretation**

3. Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting from subregulation (1) the definitions of "Australian permanent resident", "close relative" and "refugee status".

**Repeal of Part VI**

4. Part VI of the Principal Regulations is repealed.
