## AMENDMENTS OF THE TRADE COMMISSIONERS REGULATIONS<sup>2</sup>

- 1. Regulation 6 of the Trade Commissioners Regulations is Travelling allowance in Australia
  - (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1) "\$38.35" and substituting "\$41.15"; and
  - (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (1) "\$49.00" and substituting "\$53.00".
- 2. The amendments effected by regulation 1 apply in relation to an Application absence of a Commissioner from his headquarters, being headquarters in Australia or elsewhere, on official duty in Australia after 30 April 1979.
