The Parliament of Australia enacts:

1 Short title

This Act is the *Crimes Amendment (Penalty Unit) Act 2017*.

2 Commencement

1 Subsection 4AA(1) (definition of *penalty unit*)

Omit “\$180”, substitute “\$210”.

2 Subsection 4AA(3)

Omit “1 July 2018”, substitute “1 July 2020”.
