# NOTICE OF DECLARATION OF SECURITY CONTROLLED AIRPORT AND ESTABLISHMENT OF AIRSIDE AREA – GLADSTONE AIRPORT

I, **RAYMOND THESEIRA**, A/g Director, Transport Security Operations, Aviation and Maritime Security Division:

**REVOKE**, under subsection 28(2) of the *Aviation Transport Security Act 2004*, NTC -10621 which declared Gladstone Airport as a security controlled airport as published in the *Gazette* (No. C2016G00422, 30 March 2016);

**DECLARE**, under subsection 28(2) of the Act, that Gladstone Airport is a security controlled airport, the boundaries of Gladstone Airport are shown on the attached map which forms part of this notice; and

**ESTABLISH**, in accordance with section 29 of the Act, an airside area for Gladstone Airport being that area indicated as the airside area on the attached map.

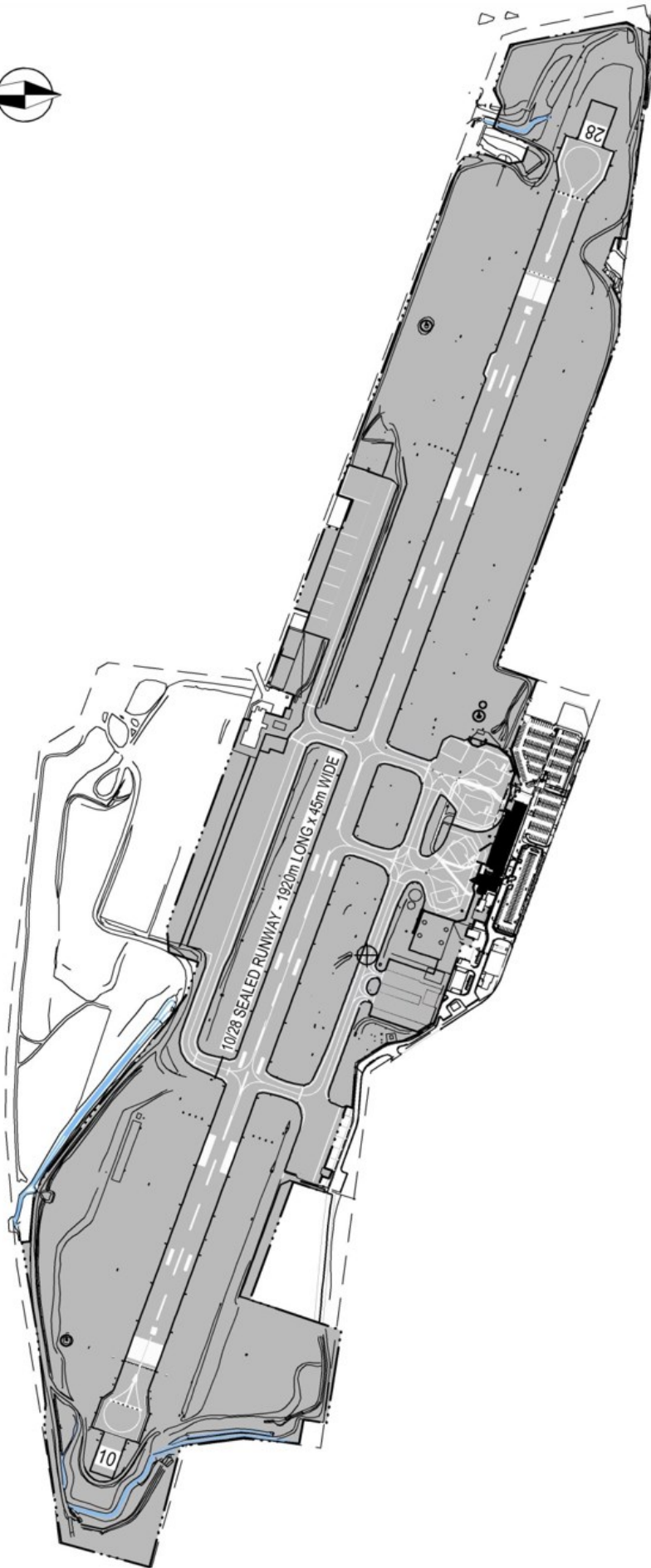
