# NTC-22247 - DECLARATION OF SECURITY CONTROLLED AIRPORT AND ESTABLISHMENT OF AIRSIDE AREA – BROOME INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

I am a Delegate of the Secretary of the Department of Home Affairs (Secretary). Under subsection 28(2) of the *Aviation Transport Security Act 2004* (the Act), I:

**REVOKE** notice NTC-21824 which declared Broome International Airport as a security controlled airport published in the *Gazette* (C2021G00837 on 4 November 2021); and

**DECLARE** that Broome International Airport is a security controlled airport, the boundaries of Broome International Airport are shown on the attached maps which form part of this notice; and

**ESTABLISH**, in accordance with section 29 of the Act, an airside area for Broome International Airport being that area indicated as the airside area on the attached maps which form part of this notice.

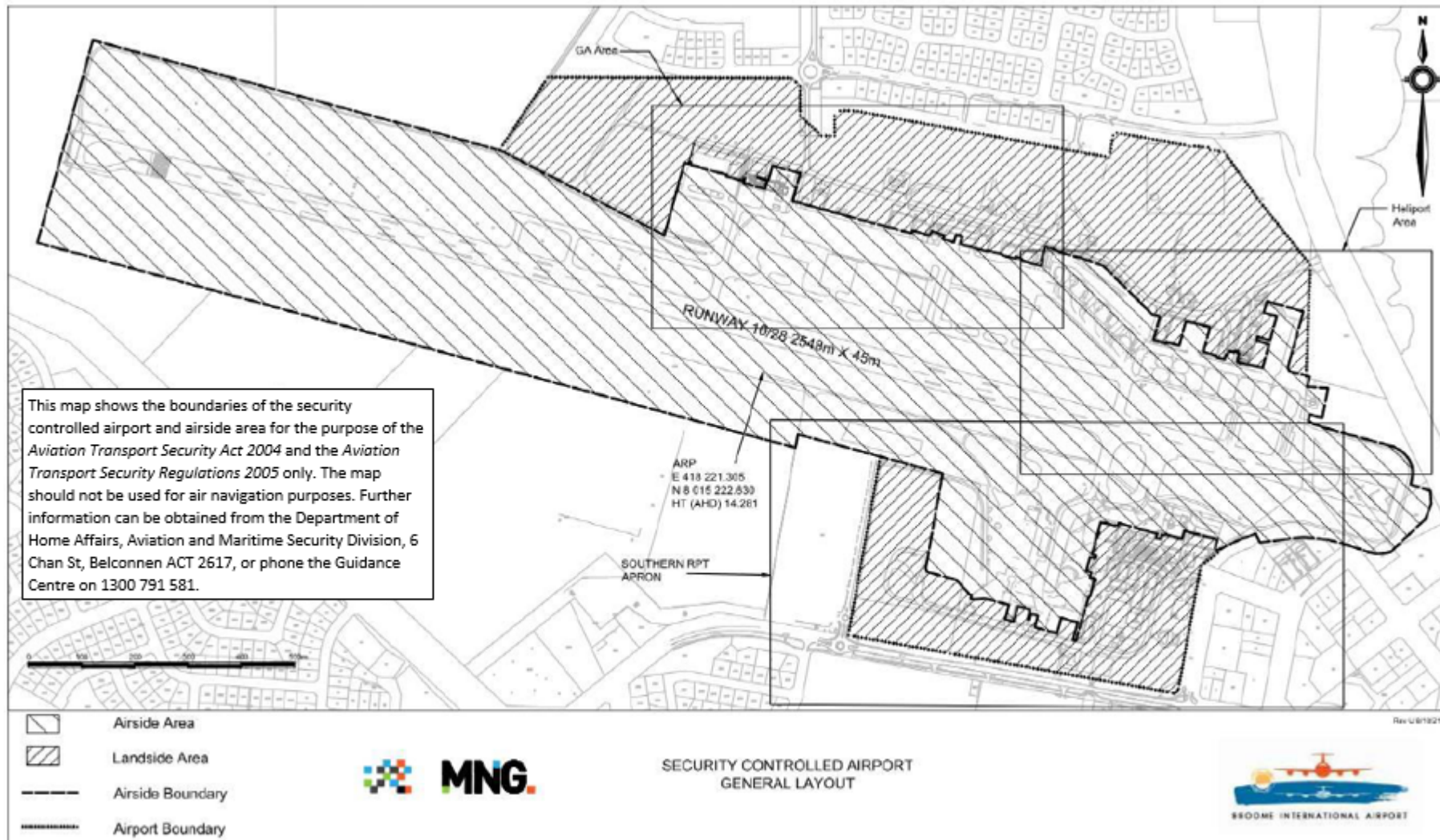
This Notice commences upon publication in the *Gazette*.
