Invitation to comment on a trial of a genetically modified vaccine against devil facial tumour disease in Tasmanian devils.

The Gene Technology Regulator is assessing an application from the University of Tasmania to conduct a trial, under limited and controlled conditions, of a genetically modified (GM) vaccine for the prevention and/or treatment of devil facial tumour disease in Tasmanian devils. The GM vaccine would be administered to Tasmanian devils kept in enclosures within trial sites in Tasmania.

The Regulator has prepared a Risk Assessment and Risk Management Plan (RARMP) for this application and welcomes written submissions relating to the protection of human health and safety and the environment prior to making a decision on whether to issue the licence.
