Schedule 1—Amendments

Criminal Code Act 1995

1 Subsection 119.2(6) of the *Criminal Code*

Omit “2024”, substitute “2027”.

2 At the end of section 119.3 of the *Criminal Code*

Add:

Sunset provision

(9) This section ceases to have effect at the end of 7 September 2027.

Intelligence Services Act 2001

3 Paragraph 29(1)(bbaa)

Repeal the paragraph.
