NTC-28005 - DECLARATION OF SECURITY REGULATED PORT – PORT WALCOTT

I am a Delegate of the Secretary of the Department of Home Affairs. Under subsection 13(1) of the *Maritime Transport and Offshore Facilities Security Act 2003* (the Act), I:

REVOKE Notice M01096 which declared the port of Port Walcott as a security regulated port as published in the *Gazette* (C2013G01292, 26 August 2013); and

DECLARE that the area of the port of Port Walcott intended for use either wholly or partly in connection with the movement, loading, unloading, maintenance or provisioning of security regulated ships, the boundaries of which are shown on the attached map, to be a security regulated port.

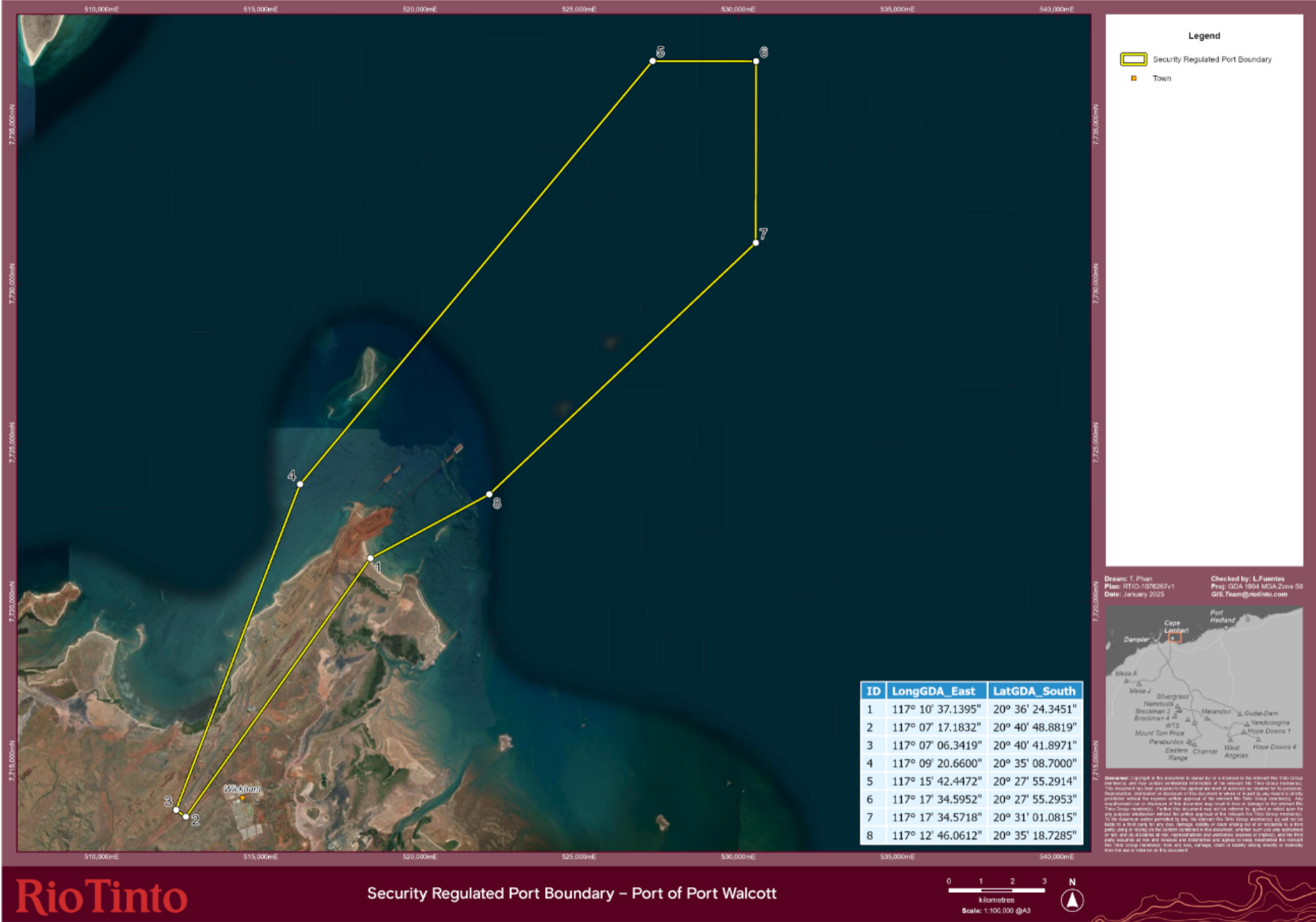
