Superannuation (CSS) (Involuntary Retirement) Regulations

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Superannuation (CSS) (Involuntary Retirement) Regulations.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears:

“the Act” means the *Superannuation Act 1976*.

Prescribed circumstances in which a person retires, or has employment or appointment terminated

3. For the purposes of paragraph 58 (3) (h) of the Act, a person’s retirement under section 127, 128 or 137 of the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* of the Australian Capital Territory is a prescribed circumstance in which the person retires otherwise than under the Public Service Act.
