1. These Regulations may be cited as the Federal Proceedings (Costs) Regulations.

### Commencement

2. These Regulations commence on 1 September 1991.

## Interpretation

3. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears: "the Act" means the Federal Proceedings (Costs) Act 1981.

## Prescribed maximum amounts: appeals or new trials

4. For the purposes of subsection 18 (1) of the Act (limits of payments in respect of appeals or other proceedings), the amount specified in an item in column 2 of the following table is the prescribed maximum amount in respect of the court specified in column 1 of the item:

High Court	10,000
Federal Court	6,000
Family Court	4,000
Supreme Court of a Territory	6,000
Other court of a Territory	2,000
