### Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Foreign Judgments Regulations.

## Interpretation

2. In these Regulations: "the Act" means the Foreign Judgments Act 1991.

### Extension of Part 2 of the Act

3. Part 2 of the Act extends to each country specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

## **Specified superior courts**

4. For the purposes of the Act, the courts specified in column 3 of an item in the Schedule are taken to be superior courts of the country specified in column 2 of that item.

## **Specified inferior courts**

5. Part 2 of the Act extends in relation to each District Court of New Zealand.
