HISTORIC SHIPWRECKS REGULATIONS

| 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Historic Shipwrecks Regulations. | Citation |
| 2. In these Regulations—
“ship” includes a hovercraft and any similar craft;
“the Act” means the <i>Historic Shipwrecks Act 1976</i> . | Interpretation |
| 3. For the purposes of sub-section 12 (3) of the Act, the prescribed fee, on payment of which a person is entitled to be furnished with a copy of, or of any part of, the Register, is 50 cents per page of the copy. | Prescribed fee for the purposes of sub-section 12 (3) of the Act |
| 4. For the purposes of section 14 of the Act, a person shall not do any of the following acts:
(a) bring into a protected zone equipment constructed or adapted for the purpose of diving, salvage or recovery operations, or any explosives, instruments or tools the use of which would be likely to damage or interfere with a historic shipwreck or a historic relic situated within that protected zone;
(b) use within a protected zone any such equipment, explosives, instruments or tools;
(c) cause a ship carrying any such equipment, explosives, instruments or tools to enter, or remain within, a protected zone;
(d) trawl, or dive or engage in any other underwater activity, within a protected zone;
(e) moor or use ships within a protected zone, except in accordance with a permit granted under sub-section 15 (1) of the Act. | Prohibition of certain activities in protected zone |
- Penalty: \$1,000 or imprisonment for 1 year, or both.
