AMENDMENTS OF THE HISTORIC SHIPWRECKS **REGULATIONS**[†]

Regulation 4 of the Historic Shipwrecks Regulations is Prohibition amended-

- (a) by omitting "Penalty: \$1,000 or imprisonment for 1 year, protected zone or both."; and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:

"(2) A person who, without reasonable excuse, contravenes this regulation is guilty of an offence and is punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment for 1 year, or both.".
