REGULATIONS UNDER THE COMMERCE (TRADE DESCRIPTIONS) ACT 1905-1950.*

AMENDMENT OF THE COMMERCE (IMPORTS) REGULATIONS.†

1. These Regulations shall come into operation upon the expiration of three months after the date on which they are notified in the *Gazette*. Commencement.

2. The Third Schedule to the Commerce (Imports) Regulations is amended by omitting from the words specified under the heading "Miscellaneous goods—" the word "Flannelette;". Third Schedule.
