REGULATIONS UNDER THE COMMERCE (TRADE DESCRIPTIONS) ACT 1905-1950.\*

Amendment of the Commerce (Imports) Regulations.

- 1. These Regulations shall come into operation upon the expiration commencement. of three months after the date on which they are notified in the Gazette.
- 2. The Third Schedule to the Commerce (Imports) Regulations is Third Schedule. amended by omitting from the words specified under the heading "Miscellaneous goods—" the word "Flannelette;".
