REGULATIONS UNDER THE COMMERCE (TRADE DESCRIPTIONS)
ACT 1905-1950.*

AMENDMENTS OF THE COMMERCE (IMPORTS) REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 7 of the Commerce (Imports) Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (g) of sub-regulation (1.). Conditional prohibition of certain imports.
2. Regulation 15 of the Commerce (Imports) Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulations (10.), (14.) and (16.). Articles of apparel, textile products and leather.
