1. Amendment

By His Excellency's Command,

1.1 The Export Control (Unprocessed Wood) Regulations are amended as set out in these Regulations.

2. Regulation 4 (Declaration of prescribed goods)

2.1 Paragraph 4 (1) (a):

Omit the paragraph, substitute:

"(a) wood chips (except wood chips declared to be prescribed goods by the Export Control (Hardwood Wood Chips) (1996) Regulations);".

[Note: The Note to subregulation 4 (1) is taken to be omitted, and the following note substituted:
