Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage Regulations² (Amendment)

1. Amendment

1.1 The Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage Regulations are amended as set out in these Regulations.

2. Schedule (Part V—Natural Science Objects of Australian Origin)

2.1 Paragraph 2 (i):

Omit the paragraph, substitute:

“(i) any holotype of Australian origin:

- (i) not lodged in an overseas collecting institution; or
- (ii) in relation to which a permit under section 24 of the *Wildlife Protection (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1982* is not in force.”.
