## Statutory Rules 1983 No.192

Issued by the authority of the Attorney-General

Family Law (Judges) Regulations (Amendment)

Sub-section 21(3) of the <u>Family Law Act 1975</u> provides that the Family Court of Australia is to consist of a Chief Judge and of Senior Judges and other Judges, not exceeding 6 in total, or such greater number as may be prescribed by regulations from time to time. The Family Law (Judges) Regulations, prior to the above amendment, prescribed this number as 42. The above regulation provides for an increase in the maximum number prescribed from 42 to 47.
