AMENDMENT OF THE PROTECTION OF WORD "ANZAC" REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 2 of the Protection of Word "Anzac" Regulations is Prohibition of use in trade amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "the Governor-&c., of word General or of a Minister of State" and inserting in their stead the words "Anzac". "the Attorney-General".
