### AIR ACCIDENTS (COMMONWEALTH GOVERNMENT LIABILITY) REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Accidents (Commonwealth Government Liability) Regulations. Citation
2. In these Regulations, "the Act" means the *Air Accidents (Commonwealth Government Liability) Act 1963*. Interpretation
3. For the purposes of the definition of "Commonwealth authority" in section 4 of the Act, each body corporate (not being a company, society or association) that is incorporated for a public purpose by a law of a Territory is declared to be a body corporate in relation to which the Act applies. Bodies corporate to which Act applies
