REGULATIONS UNDER THE AIR ACCIDENTS (COMMONWEALTH GOVERNMENT LIABILITY) ACT 1963*

AIR ACCIDENTS (COMMONWEALTH GOVERNMENT LIABILITY) REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Accidents (Common-Citation wealth Government Liability) Regulations.

2. In these Regulations, "the Act" means the Air Accidents Interpret-(Commonwealth Government Liability) Act 1963.

3. For the purposes of the definition of "Commonwealth authority" in section 4 of the Act, each body corporate (not being a company corporate to society or association) that is incorporated for a public purpose by a applies law of a Territory is declared to be a body corporate in relation to which the Act applies.
