REGULATION UNDER THE TREATY OF PEACE (GERMANY) ACT 1919-1920.*

I THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulation under the *Treaty of Peace (Germany) Act 1919-1920*.

AMENDMENT OF THE TREATY OF PEACE REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 58A of the *Treaty of Peace Regulations* is amended by adding on the end thereof the following sub-regulation:—

“(2) Subject to such modifications as the Minister approves and as are included in the contract of sale, these Regulations, other than sub-regulation (1.) of regulation 50AA, shall apply to any sale under this regulation and the amount of instalments of purchase money and the rate of interest shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of sub-regulations (2.), (3.) and (4.) of regulation 50AA.”
