Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Regulations² (Amendment)

1. Amendment

1.1 The Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Regulations are amended as set out in these Regulations.

[Note: These Regulations commence on gazettal: see *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*, s. 48.]

2. Regulation 3A (Power of Assembly to make laws)**2.1 After subregulation 3A (2), insert:**

“(2A) A law that applies, as a law of the Territory, section 70 of the National Electricity Law set out in the Schedule to the *National Electricity (South Australia) Act 1996* of South Australia, as in force at the commencement of this subregulation, is excluded from paragraph 23 (1) (h) of the Act.

[Note: Section 70 of the National Electricity Law deals with the application of funds on the winding up of National Electricity Code Administrator Limited or National Electricity Market Management Company Limited.]”.
