remuneration determination means a determination made by the Remuneration Tribunal under subsection 7 (3) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

8QD Annual rate of salary (Act, s 5 (3))

- (1) This regulation applies to an eligible employee who:
 - (a) is bound by an agreement in which express provision is made that, for the Act, the employee's annual rate of salary is an amount mentioned in, or ascertained under, the agreement; or
 - (b) is mentioned in, or is included in a class of persons mentioned in, a remuneration determination in which express provision is made that, for the Act, the employee's annual rate of salary is an amount mentioned in, or ascertained under, the remuneration determination.
- (2) Despite any other provision in these regulations, for the Act, the annual rate of salary on a particular day for the employee is an amount equal to the amount, per annum, referred to in subregulation (1).
