

Schedule 1 Amendments

(regulation 3)

[1] Subregulation 3 (1), after definition of poison schedule classification

pool or spa hypochlorite means a chemical product that:

- (a) is for use in a swimming pool or spa that is for use by human beings; and
- (b) is a formulation of calcium hypochlorite, lithium hypochlorite or sodium hypochlorite that complies with the standard (if any) last published for that formulation by the NRA in the *Gazette* and in force on 31 October 1999.
