1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Proceeds of Crime Amendment Regulations 2000 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

(1) For subparagraph 34C (1) (a) (iv) of the Act, the prescribed annual management fee payable on 27 December 2000 is \$10 413.

(1A) For subparagraph 34C (1) (a) (iv) of the Act, the prescribed annual management fee payable on 27 December 2001, and for each subsequent year, is \$10 840.

(1B) A fee mentioned in this regulation is the price of the taxable supply within the meaning of *A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999*.
