### 1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the Navigation (Marine Casualty) Repeal Regulations 2003.

#### 2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the commencement of Schedule 1 to the *Transport Safety Investigation* (Consequential Amendments) Act 2003.

# 3 Navigation (Marine Casualty) Regulations 1990 — repeal

#### 5 Transitional

Despite the repeal of the *Navigation (Marine Casualty)* Regulations 1990, those Regulations continue to apply to an investigation commenced under those Regulations before the repeal (including an investigation completed before the repeal).
