1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Navigation (Marine Casualty) Repeal Regulations 2003*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the commencement of Schedule 1 to the *Transport Safety Investigation (Consequential Amendments) Act 2003*.

3 *Navigation (Marine Casualty) Regulations 1990 — repeal*

The following Statutory Rules are repealed:

4 *Amendment of Transport and Regional Services Legislation Amendment (Application of Criminal Code) Regulations 2002 (No. 1)*

The following provisions of the *Transport and Regional Services Legislation Amendment (Application of Criminal Code) Regulations 2002 (No. 1)* are omitted:

- regulation 14
- Schedule 12.

5 Transitional

Despite the repeal of the *Navigation (Marine Casualty) Regulations 1990*, those Regulations continue to apply to an investigation commenced under those Regulations before the repeal (including an investigation completed before the repeal).
