#### 1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the Occupational Health and Safety (Commonwealth Employment) (National Standards) Amendment Regulations 2004 (No. 1).

#### 2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

## 3 Amendment of Occupational Health and Safety (Commonwealth Employment) (National Standards) Regulations 1994



(a) in:

- (i) a building or any other structure that forms a workplace; or
- (ii) a plant, a vehicle or any other thing that is for use at a workplace; and



(b) in a way that does not constitute a risk to users until the asbestos contained in the product is disturbed.
