1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Parliamentary Entitlements* Amendment Regulations 2005 (No. 2).

2 Commencement

- (2) The class of travel entitlement of the member may be downgraded for either or both of the following purposes:
 - (a) to offset the cost of the fare of an accompanying spouse;
 - (b) to enable travel to be extended for purposes related to Parliamentary or electorate business.
