**1 Name of Regulations**

These Regulations are the *Parliamentary Entitlements Amendment Regulations 2005 (No. 2)*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on the day after they are registered.

- (2) The class of travel entitlement of the member may be downgraded for either or both of the following purposes:
- (a) to offset the cost of the fare of an accompanying spouse;
  - (b) to enable travel to be extended for purposes related to Parliamentary or electorate business.
