1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemical Products (Collection of Levy) Amendment Regulations 2006 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 July 2006.

For the purposes of the definition of *rate of levy* in subsection 12C (1) of the Act, the following rates are prescribed in respect of the 2005-2006 financial year and each succeeding financial year:

2006-2007 financial year and later financial years

- (2) For section 12C of the Act, the following rates are prescribed in respect of the 2006-2007 financial year and each succeeding financial year:
 - (a) the rate of 0.8% for the first \$1 million of leviable disposals or part thereof;
 - (b) the rate of 0.45% for any amount in excess of the first \$1 million of leviable disposals up to and including \$5 million;
 - (c) the rate of 0.3% for any amount in excess of \$5 million of leviable disposals.
