1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Child Support (Assessment) Amendment Regulations 2006 (No. 1)*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the commencement of Schedule 1 to the *Child Support Legislation Amendment (Reform of the Child Support Scheme—Initial Measures) Act 2006*.

3 Amendment of *Child Support (Assessment) Regulations 1989*

 - (ii) 0.5 each shared care child of the liable parent; and
 - (iii) 0.65 each child of the liable parent of whom the liable parent has major care; and
