- (2) Despite subsection (1), the requirement in subparagraph (c)(i) of Standard S1.9 of the *Australian Standards for the Export of Livestock* (Version 2.1, November 2006) for the certificate concerned to be given by the registered veterinarian or competent pregnancy tester who pregnancy tested the cattle or buffalo does not apply to cattle or buffalo from the Northern Territory sourced for export as slaughter or feeder animals until 1 January 2007.
