1 Name of Regulations

These Regulations are the *Terrorism Insurance Amendment* Regulations 2007 (No. 1).

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on 1 July 2007.

3 Amendment of Terrorism Insurance Regulations 2003

Schedule 1 amends the Terrorism Insurance Regulations 2003.

4 Transitional

The amendments made by Schedule 1 apply to a contract of insurance that is commenced or renewed on or after 1 July 2007.
