**1 Name of Regulations**

These Regulations are the *Terrorism Insurance Amendment Regulations 2007 (No. 1)*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on 1 July 2007.

**3 Amendment of *Terrorism Insurance Regulations 2003***

Schedule 1 amends the *Terrorism Insurance Regulations 2003*.

**4 Transitional**

The amendments made by Schedule 1 apply to a contract of insurance that is commenced or renewed on or after 1 July 2007.
